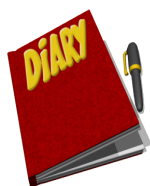

SUMMER FAYRE

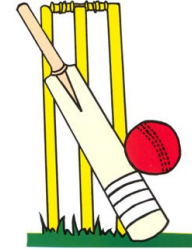
Thank you for all your contributions of bottles for the School Fayre.

Just a polite reminder that we will be holding an additional Non School Uniform Day on **12 May 2017**. Please bring donations of sweets and cakes.

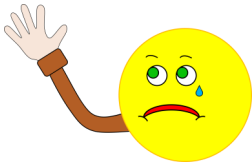
