'Colour My World' topic.

This term we are learning all about different colours. We are also looking at the traditional tales 'The Gingerbread Man' and 'The Three Little Pigs'.

Book Changing Day

Book changing day is still on Thursday from 11.10am.

Coats

Each child will need a coat in school everyday as we do indoor and outdoor lessons.

Jewellery

Children are not allowed to wear jewellery at school. If they have their ears pierced they are only allowed to wear studs and these must be removed on PE days.

PE

Our PE day is still on a Wednesday. Children need to have their ear-rings removed before they come to school. To assist with getting changed please could your child wear socks and not tights.

Attendance

We believe that good attendance at school should start in the Early Years Classes. Children who have attended all week will receive a certificate and prize. At the end of term for those children who have achieved 95% attendance from January to the end of March will be awarded £10.00 from the virtual bank to spend on uniform.

Change of clothes

Please could we remind you to send your child with a spare set of named clothes in a named bag which can be kept in school at all times.

Snack time

Please could we remind you that we still require a weekly contribution of **£1.00** to put towards a wide variety of snacks including toast, bread sticks, yogurts and other special items such as for cooking, baking and food tasting.
