Welcome to North Walsall Primary Academy Nursery class. Mrs Razaq, Miss Leonard and myself are all looking forward to getting to know your children and our new term ahead. We wanted to let you know what we will be doing this term and a few reminders.

PE

Our PE day will be Wednesday. We will be using the hall and taking the children's shoes and socks off for safety reasons. **Please remove your child's ear-rings on this day.**

Snack time:

We ask for a weekly contribution of £1.00 to put towards a wide variety of snacks including toast, bread sticks, bagels and other special items such as for cooking.

'This is Me' topic.

This term we are learning all about ourselves. Your child will bring an empty shoe box home to fill with things all about themselves which they can bring into nursery to show us. Please encourage your child to find things to put in the box, for example photographs, favourite toys, books etc. We would like your child to bring this back the next day to school to enable your child to talk about what is in their box. These will be returned at the end of the day.

Change of clothes

Please could you send your child with a spare set of named clothes in a named bag which can be kept in school at all time.

Named clothing

Please make sure you child's name is on every piece of clothing, in particular in their coats, cardigans, jumpers and shoes. We had great problems last year with missing items so this would help. Thank you.

Attendance

We believe that good attendance at school should start in Nursery and to encourage this we will be celebrating good weekly attendance every Friday with children who have attended all week receiving a certificate and prize from a special box. Please support us in this.

Earrings and Bows

Our school policy states that only stud ear-rings can be worn at school and also only small bows in your child's hairs.
