Prime Area: Communication and language

- Beginning to use more complex sentences
- Predicting what might happen next

Prime Area: Physical development

- Copying letters in our name
- Holding scissors correctly and cutting out shapes
- Climbing using alternate feet
- Balancing
- Manoeuvring round obstacles
- Moving with confidence in a range of ways, such as slithering, shuffling, rolling, crawling, walking, running, jumping, skipping, sliding and hopping
- Bean bag skills: moving round our bodies, balancing a bean bag and throwing and catching a bean bag.
- Acting out the story of Rosie's walk

Specific Area: Literacy: Reading, writing

- Describing setting and characters in a story
- Learning about our books, the author, illustrator, title and front cover.
- Writing our own name
- Beginning to write some of the sounds we are learning
