

Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back to school and to what will be a busy half term in Nursery with lots of exciting learning taking place. Here are some reminders for you.

'Spring Watch' topic.

This second half of the term we are learning all about Spring.

Book Changing Day

Book changing day is still on Thursday from 11.15am.

Coats

Each child will need a coat in school everyday as we do indoor and outdoor lessons .

Jewellery

Children are not allowed to wear jewellery at school. If they have their ears pierced they are only allowed to wear studs and these must be removed on PE days.

PE

Our PE day is still on a Wednesday. Children need to have their **ear-rings removed** before they come to school. To assist with getting changed please could your child wear socks and not tights.

Attendance

We believe that good attendance at school should start in the Early Years Classes so to encourage this we will be continuing to celebrating weekly 100% attendance every Friday. Children who have attended all week will continue to receive a certificate and choose a small prize. At the end of each term for those children who have achieved 95% attendance from January to the end of March will be awarded £10.00 from the virtual bank to spend on uniform. Please could we remind you that if someone different is collecting your child, please inform staff at the door or the office. I would also like to remind you that Nursery doors are open from **8.30-8.40am.**

Change of clothes

Please could we remind you to send your child with a spare set of named clothes in a named bag which can be kept in school at all time.

Snack time

Please could we remind you that we still require a weekly contribution of £1.00 to put towards a wide variety of snacks. This half term we will be having bread sticks, cheese straws, pancakes and yogurts. Please let us know if your child has any **allergies to these snacks.**

World Book Day

Children will be celebrating World Book Day on **Thursday 1st March** where the children can come dressed as a book character to Nursery.

Nursery Trip

Our trip is on March 27th. This is mainly outside so please make sure your child has a warm coat on. It may also be muddy if your child has a pair of wellington boots they can wear these.
