

CHILDREN ARRIVING LATE FOR SCHOOL

If your child arrives to School after the bell has gone at 8.50am, they are considered to be late for School. Children who are late, must enter School through the office area and be signed in the late book by the accompanying adult. There has been numerous occasions recently when children have arrived late, but are not being signed in the late book, which means they are being marked absent in the register. This is not only a Health and Safety risk in-case of fire, but also a safeguarding concern. Just to remind you that if your child is late on 5 or more occasions, they will not be entitled to receive 100% attendance awards.
