

Behaviour

The behaviour of pupils throughout the academy is exemplary. Relationships between pupils and adults in the academy are very strong. All staff are expected to take the time to greet and talk to pupils as they travel through the academy. There is a relentless pursuit to create a happy, respectful and purposeful learning environment. All members of the academy community must model the high standards of behaviour and conduct expected.

There is a clear system of rewards and sanctions that is well understood by pupils:

Good to be Green

In each classroom there is a Good to be Green chart displaying children's names. Behind each name are three cards which are used alongside praise and rewards.

1) **Green Card**

The majority of children will have a green card displayed by their name. This is because they have been following the code consistently.

2) **Orange Card**

Occasionally children will need a reminder of behaviour expectations in school. If a child needs reminding three times of our expectations they will be told to change their card to yellow/orange. The child will have the opportunity to go back to green if their behaviour improves within the lesson. At the end of the day the card will be changed to green ready to start the new day.

3) **Red Card**

If a child continues to demonstrate behaviour that is not in line with the class/school rules they will be instructed to change their card to red. This results in a consequence i.e. missed playtime or afterschool detention. There will be rare occasions when a child's behaviour will result in their card being changed straight to red e.g. hurting another child, verbal or racial abuse. Once a child receives a red card it is recorded and parents will be informed. Children in EYFS or KS1 must be sent to the Assistant Principal, Miss Maisey or Mrs Winwood the Pastoral Lead and KS2 pupils

to the Head of Academy, Miss Hawkins or Mrs Winwood. Persistent red cards will result in a report card and restorative plan put in place by Mrs Winwood and monitored daily, and exemption from any reward based enrichment excursions or activities will be enforced.

Rewards

Children who are green all week will be rewarded with five Dojo points and a treat from their class teacher e.g. extra break or golden time. Children who remain green for a half term will receive a privilege card and a Good to be Green postcard home, 3 privilege cards in a half term will result in an enrichment treat.

Children who are green all term will be rewarded with the opportunity to take part on Reward Day which will take place at the end of every term. They will also receive a Good to be Green postcard home.

Children who are green all year will be rewarded with a Good to be Green certificate, this will be celebrated at an end of year celebration assembly. They will also have a special excursion, which only the '1yr Good to be Green Champions' will be allowed to participate in.


