British Science Week, an initiative by British Science Association is celebrated every year. It is a celebration of Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths.

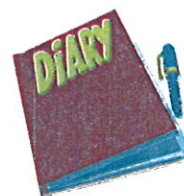
The theme this year is 'Innovating for the future.' We, at NWPA want our children to be excited and curious about science. We want them to believe in themselves.
