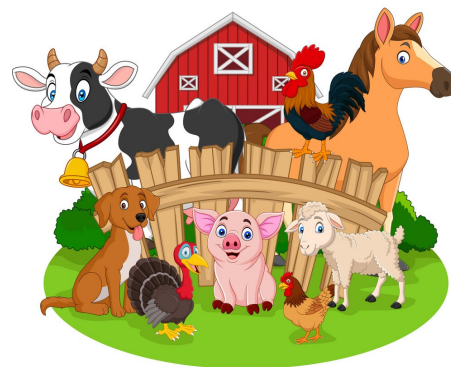
WORLD BOOK DAY 2022 AT NORTH WALSHALL PRIMARY

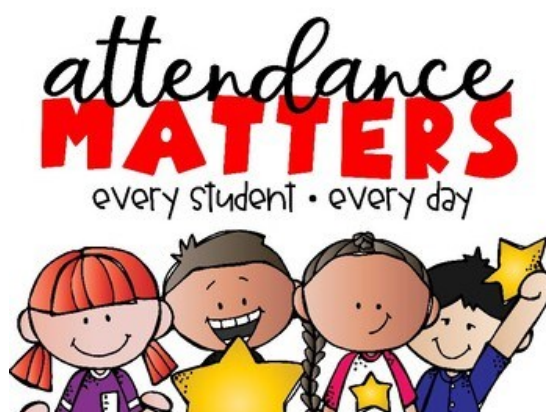
