

We wish you all the best of luck in your new school and we will miss you all!

We have a considerable amount of outstanding money for both Dinners and School Uniform. Dinner money should be paid a week in advance using your child's School Money Account. Any parents who owe dinner money on their child's account, will need to provide their child with a packed lunch, until their outstanding debt has been cleared. Please note as of September 2022, the price of school lunches will increase to £2.31 per meal, therefore £11.55 for a whole week.
