Computing

Basic Skills

- Copying and pasting
- Adding pictures to documents taken from the internet
- Typing at speed, using spell checker
- Inserting tables (add and delete rows)
- Use keyboard short cuts – eg, ctrl+c, ctrl+v
- Create hyperlinks
- Use the advanced features of Google's web search

Unit — Networking

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- This unit allows children to learn about what networks are, what they do and how they connect devices. Children also consider the safety aspects of networks, including the possible positive and negatives uses of networks.

Design Technology

This project teaches children a range of simple sewing stitches, including ways of recycling and repurposing old clothes and materials.

This project teaches children about the causes, events and consequences of the First and Second World Wars, the influence of new inventions on warfare, how life in Great Britain was affected and the legacy of the wars in the post-war period.
