Art and Design

- The Expressionist art movement and the 'Father of Expressionism', Edvard Munch. They explore different ways to portray feelings and emotions in art to create an imaginative self-portrait.
- How architectural style and technology has developed over time and then use this knowledge to design a building with specific features.

Design and Technology

- This unit teaches children about paper crafts, papermaking and collage techniques, including paper, fabric, mixed media and photo collage. They use their learning to create a final piece of small-scale, mixed media collage.

Music

- How Does Music Shape Our Way of Life?
- How Does Music Connect Us with the Environment?

History

- This project teaches children about developments and changes over six periods of ancient Greek history, focusing on the city state of Athens in the Classical age, and exploring the lasting legacy of ancient Greece.

Geography

- Analyse and compare a place, or places, using aerial photographs, atlases and maps.

Select, use and combine a variety of software (including internet services) on a range of digital devices to design and create a range of programs, systems and content that accomplish given goals, including collecting, analysing, evaluating and presenting data and information
