## Parliament

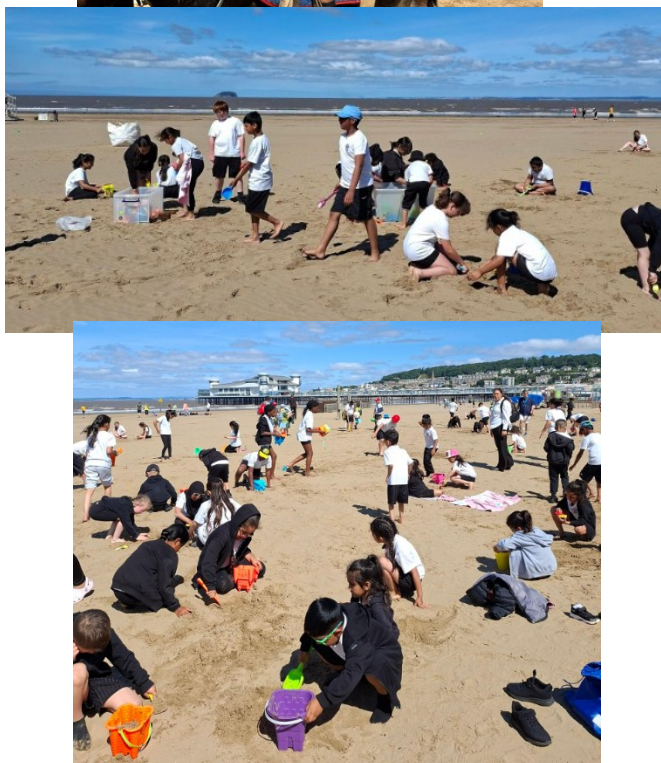
The children had a great time meeting our MP for Walsall South, Valery Vaz.
